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Dear SRCS Parents or Guardians,

We understand that the virus, now known as COVID-19, is causing many challenges in our communities, our country, and the world.

First and foremost, I want to thank you for your patience in this unpredictable time. We at SRCS want to assure everyone that we are taking precautions that are required and recommended by Governor Lujan-Grisham, the NM Public Education Dept. (NMPED) and the NM Dept. of Health (NMDOH). Governor Lujan-Grisham, along with NMPED and NMDOH, has mandated a three week closure of all New Mexico Schools from March 16 to April 6, 2020. Below are a few things our district is putting into place locally to ensure our students and staff remain safe and well cared for:

- Your child's teachers will be in contact with you early next week with some information on how to access online educational programs that are currently done at the schools and are available to utilize from home. Should you not have online access, educational packets can be prepared for pick up. We are doing this so you can keep our children's minds active and engaged during this time. This is strongly encouraged but not mandatory. High School students who are behind should make arrangements to continue with their credit recovery program (Edgenuity).
- High School students who are in dual-credit courses will have to follow their respective college's schedules and procedures.
- Please ensure your child's teacher has your most up-to-date contact information.
- Grab and Go Breakfast and lunch will be provided daily for the three weeks your child is out of school. These meals will be provided at Santa Rosa Elementary and Anton Chico Schools starting Monday, March 16, from 8:30-12:30. No one will be allowed to eat lunch on campus.
- All athletic and extra-curricular activities will be suspended until April 6, 2020. This will include practices.
- At this time, these missed days will not have to be made up. However, if that should change, we will inform you, and our calendar will be adjusted accordingly.
- The SRCS School Based Health Clinic will remain open to see students during this closure beginning on Monday, March 16th at the times indicated below:

Mondays: 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Tuesdays: Noon to 4:00 p.m.

Wednesdays: 7:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Thursdays: Noon to 4:00 p.m.
